

Reynella South School Context Statement 2019

Reynella South School provides a nurturing community of active learners from Preschool to Year 7. It has a current enrolment of approximately 178 students. The school has an ICSEA score of 973, and is classified as Category 4 on the DFE Index of Educational Disadvantage.

Reynella South School is located approximately 22kms south of the Adelaide GPO.

The school population includes 2.8% (5) Aboriginal students, 23% Students with Disabilities, 11.8% students with English as an Additional Language or Dialect (EALD), 2.8% (5) student under the Guardianship of the Minister (GoM), and 52% of students eligible for School Card assistance.

The school Leadership Team consists of the Principal, Deputy Principal (0.5FTE) and Student Well Being (0.3FTE).

There is a school-based preschool located on-site catering for early learners prior to starting school, with a current enrolment of 30 preschool students.
